

Dana Douiev presents "INJERA", a project she executed this year at Bezalel Academy of Art and Design in Jerusalem under the guidance of Prof. Ido Bruno. The project explores the Ethiopian culture of agriculture and food. Through detailed research, she began to understand the future of the Ethiopian teff and injera, which lead to the idea to design a set of utensils for its preparation, combining tradition and innovation, making the teff accessible to the modern kitchen. The teff is a "super food" and is the basis of injera, a sponge-like fermented bread that holds a monumental place in Ethiopian cuisine. These utensils aim to renew the cultural elements that have been lost through cultural migration.

The aluminium in the tabletop is unprocessed after it is hand-cast and each time it's cast it creates a unique marbling effect, making every table individual.
